2. Pledge of Allegiance
3. Open Forum/Public Comment: Johnny Wheeler would like to put on February agenda school zone and speeding signs on Perry Street and speeding on Francis Street. Alfonso Lang would like Smoking Ordinance on next month's agenda.
4. Read and approve the minutes of 12/08/2015 by Eugene Brooks, 2nd by Alfonso Lang - unanimous.

Motion to move forward and accept donations to update the monument by Johnny Wheeler, 2nd by Roger McDonald – unanimous.

Council members Eugene Brooks said the tree looked healthy and Johnny Wheeler suggested the City wait and see what the tree looks like when it blooms.
