8. Consider Extending Water Line on ACR 311 – C. Bristow. Cody Bristow discussed with council potential plans to add small subdivision within the city limits. Council had asked City Secretary in February meeting to gather information so the council could make an informed decision. City Secretary and Water Superintendent presented information to council. A motion was made to upgrade water line from a 2" to a 6" line from Hwy 175 to the potential location of the Bristow addition on CR 311. The city would pay for the replacement of the existing line since the upgrade would allow city to install much needed fire hydrants in the area. The additional 6" line being laid to the new housing area would be paid for by Cody Bristow. Motion to approve water line replacement by Mike Goodman, 2nd by Gerald Hall, Unanimous.
