

Special Meeting called to order at 2:58 pm by the Mayor Tommy Carr.

1. Consider & Discuss Quarterly Financial Review – Council was presented with the impact of inflation on our financials. In previous meetings the council voted to eliminate two open police positions. After reviewing the current financial situation, the council voted to eliminate a position in the water & sewer department as well as turning the full-time (front desk) clerk position into a part-time position. The part-time position would first be offered to the full-time clerk currently working at that desk. If they could not work part-time, they would be offered a severance package along with the employee in the water & sewer department. The council agreed to pay full medical benefits for the months of April and May along with full pay for an additional 6 weeks. Severance package to be paid for the pay periods of April 15th, April 30th, and ending May 15th. Any additional vacation or compensatory time owed to employees would be paid on May 30th, 2025. The council also reviewed our current contract with Frankston ISD for the School Resource Officer (SRO), which has not been renewed since 2011. The council would like to open talks with the school to renegotiate the contract. The council agreed to try and negotiate an 80/20% split for SROs salary, medical, and life insurance as well as a car allowance paid to the city of \$500.00 per month. Motion to approve part-time position, the elimination of a water & sewer position, severance package, and negotiation of SRO contract by Mike Goodman, 2nd by Gerald Hall, Unanimous.
