1. **Regular Meeting called to order** at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Gerald Hall.
2. **Invocation - Chief**
3. **Pledge of Allegiance**
4. **Roll Call:** Mayor Gerald Hall: Present, Councilmember Roger McDonald: Present, Councilmember Elmer Birdwell: Present, Councilmember Alfonso Lang: Absent, Councilmember Sharyn Harrison: Present, Councilmember Greg Main: Present. New Council: Lesia Main: Present; Johnnie Day: Present; Mayor Tommy Carr: Present.
5. **Consent Items:** Minutes as written for Regular Council Meeting of 4/13/21. Minutes as written for Economic Development meeting 05/3/2021. Motion to approve by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Elmer Gene Birdwell, Unanimous. Greg Main asked "Are we changing the integrity of the Gazebo by adding a chandelier?" Roger McDonald stated the "Gazebo is not totally under Economic Development. City Council should make major decisions concerning it. Topic of light poles and missing plates were discussed.
6. **Citizens Forum:** Elmer Gene Birdwell & Roger McDonald spoke against moving forward with the Special Election on November 2, 2021 to consider Legalizing Sale of All Alcoholic Beverages Including Mixed Beverages. They urged council to vote against bringing alcohol into local restaurants.
7. **New Business:**
 - a. Canvass Votes of May 1, 2021 General Election. Motion to approve Official Election Results by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Elmer Gene Birdwell, Unanimous. Mayor Gerald Hall said it had been an honor to serve as Mayor & thanked the council, citizens and employees & offered to help in anyway possible. The Council thanked him for his service to the community.
 - b. Issue Certificate of Election and Statement of Officer to new council.
 - c. Administer Oath of Office (Linda Howell – Court Clerk) – Newly sworn officers may be seated and assume duties. At this time old council members stepped down and new council members took their seat. All 6 places on council took oath of office.
 - d. Appoint Mayor Pro-Tem. Mayor Carr spoke about Sharyn Harrison experience as Mayor Pro-Tem. Johnnie Day nominated Sharyn Harrison as Mayor Pro-Tem, Greg Main 2nd, Unanimous.
 - e. Designate authorized personnel (Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, City Secretary) for signatures cards to Austin Bank. Motion to approve Mayor Tommy Carr, Mayor Pro-Tem Sharyn Harrison & City Secretary Kelli Landreth-Smith to signature cards and remove Gerald M. Hall by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Greg Main, Unanimous.
 - f. Consider calling a Special Election for November 2, 2021 to consider Legalizing Sale of All Alcoholic Beverages Including Mixed Beverages -Economic Development. Roger McDonald spoke against. Johnnie Day & Mayor Carr explained to council this was not something the board could vote against. They explained it was the council's legal duty to honor the petition and call for a special election. Motion to approve by Johnny Day, 2nd by Greg Main. 3 for; 2 opposed. Motion Carries.
 - g. Consider Interlocal Agreement between City of Frankston and Anderson County Annex for mowing annex. Motion to approve by Greg Main, 2nd by Sharyn Harrison, Unanimous.
 - h. Property Maintenance: All of Ken Adams properties need letter sent. Donald Monn property needs letter.
8. **Items from Council:** Mayor Carr introduced himself and touched on expectations of council. He said he believed as Mayor one person should be held accountable, therefore, if there are employee issues he will be the person to address them. He also spoke about the council's role in setting policy. He wanted a transparent workplace that is centered around professionalism, not gossip.
