Regular Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by the Mayor.


Members present: Before canvass Billy Dean, Eugene Brooks, James Gouger, Johnny Wheeler, and Mark Slaughter. Billy Bussey arrived late. After canvass: Sharyn Harrison, Alfonso Lang and Roger McDonald.

1. Read and approve the minutes of 04-14-2015: Motion to approve minutes by Eugene Brooks, 2nd by Mark Slaughter - unanimous.
2. Open Forum/Public Comment: Evelyn Harris mentioned someone mowed on Murchison Street and covered the street with mounds of grass.
3. Canvass the votes of May 09, 2015 General Election: Total Votes Cast – 158, 80 Early Voting, 78 Election Day. Provisionals - Early Voting 2 cast – 2 accepted. Election Day 2 cast – 2 rejected: Sharyn Harrison Place 1 Mayor - 87 votes, James Gouger Place 1 Mayor – 61 votes, Al Mann Place 1 Mayor – 8 votes. Eugene Brooks Place 2 Council - 116 votes, Mark Slaughter Place 3 Council – 114 votes, Alfonso Lang Place 4 Council – 114 votes, Johnny Wheeler Place 5 Council – 114 votes, Roger McDonald Place 6 Council – 124 votes. Motion to accept count of the General Election by Billy Dean, 2nd by Eugene Brooks – unanimous.
4. Certificate of Election issued and Statement of Officer completed by new Council.
5. Oaths of office administered and newly sworn officers Sharyn Harrison, Eugene Brooks, Mark Slaughter, Roger McDonald, Johnny Wheeler and Alfonso Lang were seated and assumed duties. James Gouger, Billy Dean and Billy Bussey stepped down.
6. Mayor Pro Tem: Mayor Sharyn Harrison recommended Eugene Brooks and a Motion was made to appoint Eugene Brooks as Mayor Pro Tem by Alfonso Lang, 2nd by Mark Slaughter – unanimous.
7. Motion to remove James Gouger from signature cards all City accounts at Austin Bank and add Sharyn Harrison and Eugene Brooks by Eugene Brooks, 2nd by Johnny Wheeler – unanimous.
8. Facilities Tour: City Council members will meet at 5:00 pm on 6/09/2015 for a facilities show and tell before regular meeting at 6:30 pm.
9. Departmental Reports: Larry Q House – Water & Sewer: After Larry's report the Mayor reported that road to WWTP is impassable and needs to be redone and plans for the 2nd water line to WWTP need to move forward. Darren Goodman – Police: Darren had a list of items needed for animal control of about \$1000-1200 and reported he will make the cage for animal transport. Scottie Rodgers – FVFD: Fire Dept. answered 95 calls from January to May 2015.
