1. **Regular Meeting called to order** at 6:30 pm by the Mayor Tommy Carr

5. **Consent Items:** Minutes as written for Regular Council Meeting of 05/11/2021. Motion to approve by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.

7. **Old Business:** None
8. **New Business:**
 - a. Consider Replat of Block 25; Lot 1, 241 W. Aryers from one lot into two – Streck. Linda Streck was in attendance. Motion to approve replating 241 W. Aryers into two lots by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
 - b. Consider completing Jones Street Closure from Miller Street to West line of Jones Addition, Block 1 – Streck. Motion to approve closing Jones Street by Johnnie Day, 2nd by Lesia Main, Unanimous.
 - c. Consider Replat of Block 6, 109 W. Main – Barns. Motion to approve replating 109 W. Main by Lesia Main, 2nd by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
 - d. Consider Street Light at corner of Hwy 155 & Perry Street -Day. Mayor Carr agrees with Johnnie Day there is a need for a light at that corner for safety reasons. Lesia Main discussed the lack of lights North of Perry Street to the City Limits Sign. Motion to approve adding a Street Light at the Corner of Perry and Hwy 155 by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Lesia Main, Unanimous.
 - e. Property Maintenance - Mayor Carr updated council that property maintenance letters were sent to Johnny Baker, Bubba House & Donald Monn. He also updated the council that he decided to hold off on sending a letter to Ken Adams since he is in the process of selling some of his properties.
9. **Items From Council:** Mayor Carr spoke to council about importance of enforcing ordinances and how he plans on making this a priority. He also updated council on a few things he was researching to better take care of the employees. The first is short term/long term disability. The second is a sick-time pool that employees could donate to if additional help is needed. He also talked about paying overtime instead of compensatory time. He wanted the council's thoughts on these item and when the time is right, he will present them for a vote. Sharyn Harrison said she liked what Mayor Carr had to say last meeting about the importance of the mayor being able to handle employee issues & it is important for the council to pass on this information to the mayor. The employees do not need to answer to all 6 council members, just the mayor. Lesia Main asked Chief Goodman if Officer Jody Coats worked full-time & do we have police coverage 7 days a week? Chief Goodman explained Officer Coats is a full-time officer who works a 40-hour week but is also on call 24/7 as the K9 officer. He said he has an officer working 7 days a week but cannot offer 24-hour coverage everyday with the number of officers he has on staff. Johnnie Day spoke to the Chief about speeding on Perry Street. Chief said they will monitor it. If they are aware of an issue they can focus on the area where the issue is. Johnnie Day thanked the Chief for his hard work.
