5. **Consent Items:** Council Meeting 05/13/2025. Motion to approve by Mike Goodman, 2nd by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
6. **Citizens Forum:** Several citizens attended the meeting and spoke up on various concerns.  - c. Consider & Discuss Burning Debris Located at Cemetery from Storm. Motion to approve renting a bulldozer and having water & sewer department burn debris by Johnnie Day, 2nd by John Bowen, Unanimous
 - d. Consider & Discuss if For or Against Permits Filed by Pine Bliss, LLC & Redtown Ranch Holdings, LLC. The City of Frankston is in both Anderson & Henderson County, which both areas are potentially adversely affected by the water wells. All council members are against the drilling of the water wells in our area. Motion Against permits being issued to Pine Bliss, LLC & Redtown Ranch Holdings, LLC as well as to offer full support to both Anderson & Henderson counties in the fight against issuing permits to Pine Bliss, LLC & Redtown Ranch Holdings, LLC by John Bowen, 2nd by Johnnie Day, Unanimous
