


August 9, 2022

- 1) **Regular Meeting called to order** at 6:28 p.m. by Mayor Tommy Carr
- 2) **Invocation** – Tommy Carr
- 3) **Pledge of Allegiance**
- 4) **Roll Call:**
Members Present: Tommy Carr, Johnnie Day, Roger McDonald, Sharyn Harrison, Gerald Hall
- 5) **Consent Items:** Read and approve the minutes from Regular Council meeting 07/12/22. Economic Development Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 & Economic Development minutes 8/1/2022. Motion to approve minutes & Economic Development Budget by Johnnie Day, 2nd by Roger McDonald - Unanimous.
- 6) **Citizen Forum:** None
- 7) **Old Business:**
 - a. Consider Moving Forward for Grant through ETCOG for Recycle Center. Council agreed it is a great thing to have a recycling center, but the city needed to focus on an education program about recycling before setting up a recycle center. The Moynihan's said they would research educational material to hand out to the public. Motion denied at this time by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
 - b. Consider Time for Upcoming Budget Meeting on August 16th. The mayor proposed to hold the meeting on the 16th at 3:00 p.m. The council were all in agreement. No formal action taken.

 - a) Consider Replat for Property 308 W. Murchison – Cain Surveying. Motion to approve replat by Johnnie Day, 2nd by Gerald Hall, Unanimous.
 - b) Consider Mobile Home Variance 308 ACR 300 – C. Shackelford. There was no opposition to variance. Motion to approve by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Gerald Hall, Unanimous.
 - c) Consider Mobile Home Variance 502 W. Main – K. Patrick. There were 3 letters of opposition from neighboring property owners. After discussion from the council there was a motion to approve by Roger McDonald, 2nd by Gerald Hall. There was a split vote: 3 FOR;1 AGAINST. Motion passes.
 - d) Consider Storage Building for Greg Porter. Storage building to be placed on corner on Murchison & Francis Street. Motion to approve by Johnnie Day, 2nd by Sharyn Harrison, Unanimous.
 - e) Consider Street Light on N. Garrison Street to be located by 602 N. Garrison. Sharyn Harrison stated that the area was dark and needed a streetlight. Motion to approve by Johnnie Day, 2nd by Gerald Hall, Unanimous.
 - f) Property Maintenance – The mayor spoke to council and audience about filling out a formal complaint form at city hall to help us enforce areas that may be in violation of city's property maintenance ordinance.
