

1. **Regular Meeting called to order** at 6:30 pm by Tommy Carr.
2. **Invocation-** Tommy Carr
3. **Pledge of Allegiance**
4. **Roll Call:** Mayor Tommy Carr: Present, Councilmember Roger McDonald: Present, Councilmember Johnnie Day: Present, Councilmember Lesia Main: Present, Councilmember Sharyn Harrison: Present, Councilmember: Greg Main, Present.
5. **Consent Items:** Minutes as written from 7/13/21. Motion to approve minutes as written by Greg Main, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
6. **Citizens Forum:** Eugene Brooks invited Council to Annual Cemetery Meeting on Sept 2 at 7:00 p.m. at Anderson County Annex in Frankston.
7. **New Business:**
  - a. Consider Re-Plat 230 Elizabeth Street – P. Streck. Citizen was a not in attendance and not enough detailed information to make informed decision. Motion to table by Greg Main, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
  - b. Consider Creating Ordinance for the sale & use of fireworks 500' outside of City Limits – L. Main. Councilmember Lisa Main spoke to council about citizens complaining of fireworks over the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and asked for consideration to create a fireworks ordinance. Council split on best way to move forward. Consensus made by council to gather more research before moving forward. Motion to table by Roger McDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sharyn Harrison, Unanimous.
  - c. Consider National Night Out on Tuesday, October 5, 2021 – E. Brooks. Eugene Brooks spoke to council about rescheduling event with COVID cases on the rise. Council agreed to look at rescheduling at more appropriate time due to COVID. Motion to table by Greg Main, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
  - d. Consider Establishing School Zone on Perry Street & set speed limit to 15 mph – J. Day. Councilmember Day spoke to the council about the need to establish all of Perry Street (from Hwy 155 to Reagan St) as a designated school zone with at 15 mph speed limit and prohibited cell phone use. All councilmembers agreed there was a need to establish Perry Street as a designated school zone at 15 mph as well as to prohibit cell phone use in all designated school zones. Motion to establish ordinance to be presented at upcoming meeting by Roger McDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Greg Main, Unanimous.
  - e. Discuss City Ordinances – Mayor Carr spoke to the council about his plan to enforce ordinances currently on the books. He hoped it would be seen as a positive in the community. He asked for the council support as he moves toward higher enforcement of city ordinances.
  - f. Discuss Current COVID Conditions – Mayor Carr spoke to the council about the rising cases of COVID in the area. He informed the council that city hall would be following all CDC guidelines, wearing mask and social distancing for the safety of the employees and citizens who visit city hall.
  - g. Consider changing Line Item for Grant on FVFD Budget – D. Hicks. The current linen item on FVFD budget reads vehicle grant. Fire Chief Doug Hicks has applied for an additional grant for fire equipment as well as the vehicle grant. He wanted to change the line item on budget to read Grant so if he needed additional money to use after receiving either grant, that money

would be available for both grants. Motion to approve changing line item on budget to read Grant by Greg Main, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.

- h. Consider adding Donation Option for Library & FVFD on Water Bill. Motion to approve giving option for citizens to donate to Library & FVFD on monthly water bill by Greg Main, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
- i. Consider Signs for Sidewalks in Downtown Area Prohibiting Skateboarding & Bike Riding – R. McDonald. Councilmember McDonald spoke about safety concerns for citizens in downtown area. He asked to prohibit bikes and skateboards on the downtown sidewalk to eliminate the risk of a citizen getting hit coming in and out of the businesses. Motion to approve creating ordinance to be presented at upcoming meeting prohibiting skateboarding and riding bikes on downtown sidewalks by Roger McDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sharyn Harrison, Unanimous.
