


October 12, 2021

2. **Invocation - Chief**
3. **Pledge of Allegiance**
4. **Roll Call:** Mayor Tommy Carr: Present, Councilmember Roger McDonald: Present, Councilmember Sharyn Harrison: Present, Councilmember Lesia Main: Present by Phone, Councilmember Johnnie: Present, Councilmember Greg Main: Present by Phone.
5. **Consent Items:** Minutes as written for Regular Council Meeting of 9/14/21, Special Meetings 9/27/21 & 10/4/21; Minutes as written for Economic Development meeting 10/04/2021. Motion to approve minutes by Roger McDonald, 2nd by Sharyn Harrison, Unanimous. Motion to reappoint Gary Tomas for 2021-2022 year by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Greg Main, Unanimous.
6. **Citizens Forum:** Johnny Burks addressed council concerning the plans he submitted to city for city engineer to review. Mayor Carr said he would meet with him after the meeting to discuss in further detail.
7. **New Business:**
 - a. Consider Changes to Farmers Market – S. Norris. Saffire Norris addressed council about becoming the Market Manager for the farmer’s market. She would like to add dairy, meat and other items covered under the Texas Cottage Act. She would work closely with city hall on permitting and regulations to ensure a strong working relationship. She proposes the farmer’s market stay on the south side of the park with a \$10.00 booth fee that would be used to grow the market. She would like to hold the market every Saturday from April though December. Motion to appoint Saffire Norris as Farmer’s Market Manager by Johnnie Day, 2nd by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
 - b. Adopt Ordinance 101221 Establishing School Zone on Perry. Motion to approve by Sharyn Harrison, 2nd by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
 - c. Adopt Ordinance 101221-B Prohibiting Cell Phone use in School Zone. Motion to approve by Greg Main, 2nd by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
 - d. Adopt Ordinance 101221-C Prohibiting Bikes on Downtown Sidewalk. Motion to approve by Greg Main, 2nd by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
 - e. Consider Audiovisual Equipment for Council Chambers. Mayor Carr spoke to council about installing equipment to record and upload meetings to our website to better serve community. Motion to approve by Roger McDonald, 2nd by Jonnie Day, Unanimous.
 - f. Property Maintenance – Johnnie Day brought up the hole in the parking lot at the old Phillips Station and asked when the hole was going to be filled. Mayor Carr asked Water & Sewer Superintendent to fill in hole when he had time. Mayor Carr encourage council to focus on an area of town each week for property maintenance.
