4. **Roll Call:** Mayor Tommy Carr: Present, Councilmember Roger McDonald: Present, Councilmember Sharyn Harrison: Present, Councilmember Lesia Main: Absent, Councilmember Johnnie Day: Present, Councilmember Greg Main: Absent.
5. **Consent Items:** Minutes as written for Regular Council Meeting of 10/12/21. Motion to approve by Roger McDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
6. **Citizens Forum:** Martha Thompson thanked Gerald Hall, Cody Hall, and Michael Barr from the FVFD for responding to an emergency call for her son Hunter. She wanted to publicly thank them for their kindness and professionalism the night of his passing.
7. **New Business:**
  - a. Consider Memorial Plaque for City Park – D. Smith. Dale Smith presented a packet to the council detailing the history of the tree he planted in 1977 at the city park and his desire to put a memorial plaque at the foot of the tree. Motion to approve memorial plaque by Sharyn Harrison, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Johnnie Day, Unanimous.
  - b. Consider Electronic Sign for Advertisement – Economic Development. Jim Dwyer and Jamey Lade spoke the council about placing an electronic sign at the FVFD to help businesses advertise as well as to use as a PSA board. Jim Dwyer said he would seek permission from FVFD if council approves. Motion to approve by Sharyn Harrison, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
  - c. Update on Purchase of 3.2 acres on West Side of City Park – Economic Development. Jim Dwyer and Jamie Lade addressed council about where they were in the process. The Railroad is asking a minimum of \$25K for land and Economic Development has put in a bid for 25K, plus closing as well as requested a survey.
  - d. Approve Minutes as written Economic Development Meeting 11/1/2021. Motion to approve by Roger McDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sharyn Harrison, Unanimous.
  - e. Discuss Grant for 108K for Water & Sewer. Mayor Carr said he would like to see the money go toward a generator for the North side of town and asked the council to think of any areas the money would be of good use under the areas the grant can be spent. Mayor Carr said he planned on presenting this as an agenda item next meeting.
  - f. Consider Traffic Study at Hwy 155 & Perry. Motion to approve traffic study Johnnie Day, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger McDonald, Unanimous.
  - g. Update on Street Project. Mayor Carr spoke about letters being sent out to inform citizens of the upcoming Town Hall meeting on November 23<sup>rd</sup>. He gave an overview of what the city hoped to accomplish with the street project and encouraged citizens to attend the upcoming Town Hall meeting to learn more.
  - h. Canvass Vote for Proposition A – The Legal Sale of All Alcoholic Beverages Including Mixed Beverages – November 2, 2021 Election. Official Vote of 55 For and 39 Against. Motion to canvass vote by Roger McDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jonnie Day, Unanimous.
